Please keep this in mind when dressing your children for school. We all need warm jackets, hats and mittens for the playground.

When choosing gloves or mittens, please remember **mittens are warmer**. For safety reasons on the playground, gloves or mittens should have a **nonskid palm**.

All children need to be able to dress and undress themselves with out help by winter (yes that does include snowpants!). Please practice at home.

If your child can not put on his or her coat in the conventional way, show them how to lay it on the floor (inside of coat should be facing up) in front of them with the collar or hood at their feet. Have them bend over to put both their arms in the sleeves. Lift and flip the coat over their head. Voila! Their coat is on! We call this 1, 2, flip-a-roo.

In the Classroom

November will be an aromatic month! We'll be cooking and baking in all classes.

Cooking with young children is a great opportunity to concretely explore and discuss concepts:

Math: counting, measuring, **Science:** cause and effect, use of ingredients, properties and change, nutrition

Social studies: traditions associated with harvest celebrations, family

Language: use of a recipe, vocabulary and descriptive language using adjectives and adverbs, following directions

Social skills: turn taking, working as a group
